Citizens expressed concerns regarding Limestone County Road 374, particularly the impact of gravel truck traffic along the county road. Issues raised included damage to personal vehicles, deterioration of the roadway, removal of barricades, and concerns related to trash, dust levels, and the safety of children in the area. Overall, citizens indicated support for closing the road to thru truck traffic. A representative from Connors Crushed Stone spoke in favor of keeping the road open. The representative stated that they have been in communication with the Commissioners about making repairs to the road and are prepared to do so pending written authorization. The primary concerns expressed by Connors Crushed Stone were the increased mileage required to access job site.
