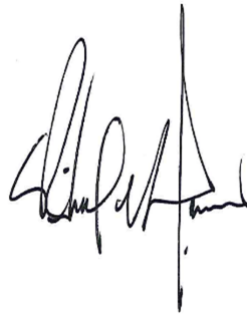
19. EXECUTIVE SESSION:
