NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with Chapter 551 of the Government Code (§ 551.001, et. seq.) "The Open Meetings Act", as amended, that a **SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING** of the Limestone County Commissioners Court, the governing body of Limestone County, will be held Wednesday, July 8, 2026, at 3:00 PM, in the County Courtroom, Limestone County Courthouse, 200 W. State St., Groesbeck, Texas, at which time the following Agenda will be considered:

EMERGENCY/URGENT PUBLIC NECESSITY

The Commissioners Court finds that an emergency or urgent public necessity exists requiring immediate action due to the unexpected resignation of the County Treasurer, the resulting vacancy in that office, the appointment of a successor to fill the vacancy, and the immediate need to qualify the appointee to perform essential treasury functions. Immediate action is necessary to avoid disruption of critical county financial operations, including payroll processing, safeguarding county funds, receipt and disbursement of county monies, and other statutory duties of the County Treasurer. The Commissioners Court further finds that the circumstances arose from a reasonably unforeseeable situation requiring immediate action before the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Court.

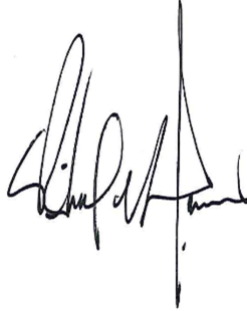
